THE DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

- Online applications successfully filled through the website daman.nic.in/ojas within the stipulated time limit will only be considered. The candidates are advised to fill their active e-mail address and mobile number in the online application as all the correspondence will be made by SSB or the respective department including the offer of appointment etc through email and /or SMS. Any excuses by the candidates such as he / she did not check email and hence could not meet the deadlines will not be considered.
- 2) The candidate should submit applications within the stipulated time limit.
- For the Post of Primary / Upper Primary School Teacher (English Medium), the online Computer based Examination will be conducted in English only.
- 4) The written examination will be Computer based. The marks for preparation of Merit List will be awarded only for Written Examination. No other marks will be awarded.
- 5) The exam centre allotted to the candidate will be final and the admit card issued will be valid only for the centre allotted/mentioned in the admit card. No request for change of centre at any stage of the selection process will be entertained. However, the allotment/ change of centre to the candidate can be at the sole discretion of the Board.
- The Merit List will be prepared from 100 marks of Computer based Examination. There will be 100 Questions in the Computer based examination carrying 01 mark each. For each wrong answer 0.25 marks will be deducted. 33% will be the passing cut off in the Computer based examination.
- 7) The closing date for submission of application will be the crucial date for meeting eligibility conditions including age and educational qualifications. The candidate should have received certificate / mark sheets before the closing date of submission of application.
- 8) Candidature of the candidates found to be using unfair means will be cancelled automatically and further action including debarring from all future exams and criminal proceeding may be initiated.
- 9) Admission of the candidate to examination centre. The decision of the Board as to eligibility or otherwise of a candidate for admission will be final.

10) Penalty:

Any candidate who is or has been, declared by the Board to be guilty of-

- a) Obtaining support for his candidature by any means; or
- b) Impersonation; or
- c) Procuring impersonation by any person; or
- d) Submitting fabricated documents or documents which have been tampered with; or
- e) Making statements which are incorrect or false or suppressing material information; or
- f) Resorting to any other irregular or improper means in connection with his candidature for the examination; or
- g) Adopting unfair means during the examination; or
- h) Writing obscene language or pornographic matter, in the scripts; or
- i) Misbehaving with fellow examinees or the invigilators in any manner in the examination hall; or
- j) Harassing or causing bodily harm to the staff employed/engaged by the Board for the conduct of the examination; or will be proceeded against as per the available penal and disciplinary provisions. The candidate will also be debarred from giving the examination.

- 11) Candidature of the candidate will be cancelled, if he/she found guilty after screening of CCTV footage.
- 12) For Group "B" post, the reservation concession belonging to the Scheduled Castes / Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes should be on all India basis. The Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC should submit the Scheduled Castes / Scheduled Tribes Certificate / latest Non creamy layer certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
- 13) Upper age limit relaxation for the posts advertised will be in accordance with instructions or orders issued by the Central Government, issued from time to time.
- 14) Age relaxation for Persons working on daily wages/ ad-hoc /contract/work charge basis in Departments of UT Administration of DNH & DD and autonomous bodies substantially funded by UT Administration for regular recruitment to posts by UT Administration (Except through UPSC) as per the guidelines issued by the UT Administration of DNH & DD from time to time.
- 15) The syllabus of the post will be published on the official web site daman.nic.in/OJAS. However, this syllabus is indicative and any other miscellaneous questions of general aptitude expected of a teacher can be asked.
- The application fee will be Rs.200/- (Rupees Two Hundred only). The Application fee will be non-refundable. The candidates belonging to the SC, ST, persons with disabilities and female candidates are exempted from payment of fees and for the Ex-serviceman the application fee will be Rs. 100/- (Half of the prescribed fee). The prescribed fees will be charged for each application to be deposited (Non-refundable) in the account of Staff Selection Board, DNH & DD only. - i) All PH candidates will bring their PH (Disability) certificate issued by Medical authority on the date of the Examination at the examination centre in original and a self attested photocopy of the same certificate which will be kept by the centre incharge. Only the PH Candidates who bring the disability certificate and a self attested photocopy of the same certificate will be allowed to avail the concessions applicable to PH candidates for the Computer Based test.
- ii) Any candidate who has filled up in PH category in application form and e-admit card, but does not produce his/her disability certificate and self attested photocopy of the same at the examination centre will not get the extra time benefit for the exam, applicable to PH candidates only.
- iii) PH Candidates will be eligible to avail extra time only as per laid down rules.
